Acawaia Restaurant: Settled atop a hill overlooking the homestead, the restaurant opens its doors to the public every day from 12:00 a 15:30 hrs. With its unique view of the farm and the Beagle Channel, you are invited to try typical farm and regional meals.



The Tea House: Built in part of the original main house, the Tea House offers traditional family cakes: rhubarb, chocolate, apple, lemon; scones, and home-made cookies. Open from 9:30 a 18:30 hrs.

The Shepherd's House:

This old building was originally used by shepherds and shearers who worked on the farm. In 2011 and 2014 it was remodeled and now has two triple rooms with private bathrooms, gas heaters and a shared kitchenette. It is decorated with original family artwork. From the wood deck, only meters from the beach, you have a lovely view of Harberton Bay and the rest of the homestead.

The Foreman's House Hostel:

Our hostel offers a rustic space to share with other visitors in one of the oldest buildings of the farm, which was used for many years by our foreman. Partially remodeled, it now has three double bedrooms, a shared bathroom, a modern wood burning stove in the central hall and a simple kitchen. The view of the complete homestead, the bay, the Beagle Channel and the mountains is amazing.

This fee includes only breakfast, the tour of the homestead and the Museum. A carry-out dinner may be purchased for dinner if you like.
